






Europe 2020 Strategy

Europe 2020 targets



To measure progress in meeting the Europe 2020 goals, **5 headline targets** have been agreed for the whole EU.

This limited set of EU-level targets is translated into national targets [307 KB]

in each EU country, reflecting different

situations and circumstances.

The 5 targets for the EU in 2020

1. Employment

75% of the 20-64 year-olds to be employed

2. R&D

· 3% of the EU's GDP to be invested in R&D

3. Climate change and energy sustainability

- greenhouse gas emissions 20% (or even 30%, if the conditions are right) lower than 1990
- 20% of energy from renewables
- 20% increase in energy efficiency

4. Education

- Reducing the rates of early school leaving below 10%
- at least 40% of 30-34-year-olds completing third level education

5. Fighting poverty and social exclusion


at least 20 million fewer people in or at risk of poverty and social exclusion

Europe 2020 Strategy – with stronger Focus on Results







What is a Result Indicator?

Objective

something we plan to achieve/change/influence/facilitate (result)

- reflection of an objective
- captures what we plan to achieve/change/influence/facilitate
 - variable with quantitative or qualitative information on some aspects of our objective
 - measurement unit necessary

Result Indicator

- intended value
- quantified or desired development trend after intervention (in year X)

Target



- value of indicator before intervention
- number or description of situation






Monitoring and Evaluation are integral parts of RIS3





National/regional research and innovation strategies for smart specialisation (RIS3) are integrated, place-based economic transformation agendas that do five important things

- They focus policy support and investments on key national/regional priorities, challenges and needs for knowledge-based development, including ICT-related measures;
- They build on each country's/region's strengths, competitive advantages and potential for excellence:
- They support technological as well as practice-based innovation and aim to stimulate private sector investment;
- They get stakeholders fully involved and encourage innovation and experimentation;
- They are evidence-based and include sound monitoring and evaluation systems.

Monitoring – Evaluation


Monitoring

- Gathering of data (quantitative values/qualitative information) for the defined input, output and result indicators
- Verifying
 - funds (input) are correctly used on planned policy instruments
 - spent on delivering planned outputs
 - actual result indicators evolve in the desired direction
- Normally carried out by actors responsible for implementation, also with external support
- Provides empirical basis for evaluation

Evaluation

- Assessing impact = contribution of the interventions to the result indicators
- Understand why and how the impact is achieved
- Identification of success factors & barriers
- Participatory approach with involvement of main program stakeholders and independent experts







Objectives

High satisfaction of participants with block 3

Target value: 100% of participants satisfied

Baseline value: 0%

High learning effect

Result indicator: learning share

Target value: 75% of participants learned something new in block 3 session

Baseline value: 0%

Policy = Instrument mix
